HBT POLICY: Reporting Children in Need of Protection Rehabilitation Services B-3.2

Policy Statement:

This policy provides guidance in the application of the reporting requirements under the <u>Child</u>, <u>Family and Community Service Act</u> (see *Relevant Documents/Links*).

Guidelines

1. In the course of providing rehabilitation to Employees, Rehabilitation Services reports to the Ministry of Children and Family Development if there is reason to believe a child requires protection

Practice

- 1) Rehabilitation Services will report to the Ministry of Children and Family Development if there is information from a reliable source that a child is in need of protection
- 2) Rehabilitation Services considers information from the following sources:
 - a) Self-reporting by the child's parent or care giver about abuse or neglect
 - b) Treating physician reports of abuse or neglect
 - c) Anonymous reports of abuse or neglect

Definitions
